

Eduardo VEAS MSc Univ.-Prof. Dr.techn.

Eduardo Veas is a professor for intelligent and adaptive user interfaces at Graz University of Technology since September 2019. Before becoming a professor, he was Research Manager of the Knowledge Visualization Area at Know-Center GmbH. He was also research fellow of the Institute of Interactive Systems and Data Science (TU Graz), and research fellow of CONICET. His interests lie in the field of human computer interaction, in particular studying human aware computing and cognitive aspects of data exploration in visual analytics, virtual and augmented reality interfaces.

Eduardo Veas has accumulated experience in designing (non-conventional) interfaces, from prototyping and design of specialized devices, to the implementation and evaluation of novel interfaces for exploration of environmental data, scientific documents, quality metrics for text, network behaviour. He obtained his PhD in Computer Science in 2012 from Graz University of Technology, his MSc in Information Science and Technology from Osaka University, and holds a degree in Software Engineering from National University of Technology, Argentina.

Eduardo is a recipient of the 2018 SIGCHI SIGAI Intelligent User Interfaces Best Paper Award and two time runner up for the ACM ISWC Best paper award on wearable computing.
